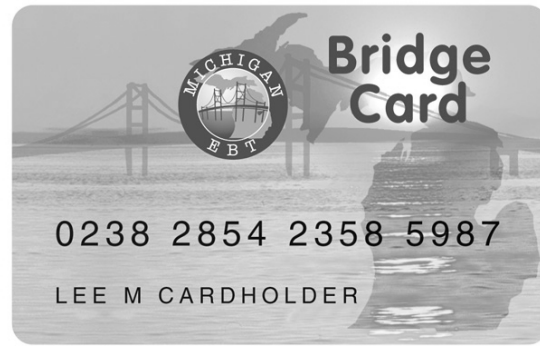

## **Double-Up Food Bucks Program Comes to Northwest Detroit Farmers' Market**

Calling all Bridge card users! There's a new program starting at the Northwest Detroit Farmers' Market (NWDFM) that will give you a great way to stretch your food budget: it's called **Double-Up Food Bucks**.

### **HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS**

The Fair Food Network has developed the Double-Up Food Bucks program to match your Bridge card purchase at any participating Michigan farmers' market, dollar for dollar up to \$20 per visit.

For example, if you bring your Bridge card to the Northwest Detroit Farmers' Market and purchase \$10 worth of EBT tokens, you will receive an additional \$10 worth of Double-Up Food Bucks, which can be used to purchase Michigan-grown fruits and vegetables only.

Talk about getting a great value for your money! Not only will you be able to buy twice as much food, you'll be getting fresh, locally grown, nutritious fruits and vegetables so important to your family's health!

### **WHEN WILL IT BEGIN: Thursday, August 12**

NWDFM Market Master Pam Weinstein said the program is available at our neighborhood's market beginning Thursday, August 12. "We'll have Double-Up Bucks every Thursday from now till the end of our season on Oct. 14. We are proud to bring this valuable program to our neighborhood, and we applaud the Fair Food Network for developing this terrific resource," Weinstein added.
